## MICHIGAN ETA TAKES HOME THE TROPHY!

For the second time in three years Sigma Phi Epsilon won Michigan Tech's annual Winter Carnival in the fraternity division. Between winning first place in Stage Revue, first place in special events, and fourth place in statue, Michigan Eta was able to beat second place overall- and perennial statue winner- Phi Kappa Tau fraternity. For many, this was the second time celebrating a Carnival win as

SigEps most recently won in 2010. But for the newer members, it was certainly a rewarding experience. "Last year was a disappointment," says second-year member and statue chair Tim Richmond, "but it was great to finally have our hard work pay off." Over 2,000 man hours were put in by the brotherhood on statue alone, all without implementing any mandatory work hours. A big
